Definition of patrology. plural -es. 1: a branch of historical theology concerned with the teachings of the fathers of the Christian church — called also patristics. 2: a collection of the writings of the church fathers. Patristics or patrology is the study of the early Christian writers who are designated Church Fathers. The names derive from the combined forms of Latin pater and Greek pat $\text{\textcircled{r}}$ (father).
